Volunteer Title: Government Relations Representative

Description:

- The Government Relations Representative will establish close working relationships with regional businesses, organizations, and governments to develop awareness and support for Breast Cancer Canada. The Government Relations Representative will also support local government, donors and stakeholders interested in collaborating with Breast Cancer Canada. This role typically requires 2-4 hours of time commitment per month, possibly more during the months of May and October. It also requires a 2-year commitment unless otherwise approved by BCC Senior Leadership.

Responsibilities:

- Work with local and provincial governments to further Breast Cancer Canada's regional and national strategy.
- Garner awareness and support of Breast Cancer Canada initiatives and events.
- Support donors and stakeholders in collaboration with Breast Cancer Canada to further breast cancer research.

Qualifications:

- A post-secondary degree or the equivalent combination of education and work experience.
- Previous experience with Breast Cancer Canada or other not-for-profit organizations is an asset.
- Demonstrated experience in a government relations role is an asset.
- Demonstrated experience in a communications based-role.
- Previous experience with donor and stakeholder outreach.
- Strong oral and written communication skills.
- Demonstrated ability to build and sustain relationships with external organizations.
